

Frequently Asked Questions.....

Do you keep copies of the photos?

- Yes yes yes!! I keep multiple copies of ALL the original photos I take at your wedding & they are always available for you to place additional orders or if you have family who would like to order from me directly.

Can you work with us on price?

- Yes. This is why I have one standard "package" price and let you choose additional options from there. If you want to make additions you can or you can save up and order additions at a later date. The only money I require before the wedding is the \$200 refundable deposit. I will shoot the wedding without any further payment. When you pay off the balance you get your photos. I am able to work with you in many different ways.. just ask! You won't find a better deal from a professional photographer with the experience I have with what you're getting in return.

How much time should we allow for photos?

Consider the start time of the wedding (lets pretend it's 5pm), subtract 1/2 hour of "seating time" for your guests to arrive and get sat, etc. So we should be finished with photos by 4:30pm. It takes at least one hour from the photo start time to complete all the regular group shots -so that puts us at 3:30pm. It's not a wedding if it's not running late so tell your wedding party to plan for pictures to start at 3pm (if it's at the same location)

What is your shooting style?

- I have many different styles given my background and training. I am able to get your standard poses that grandma wants to put on her wall as well as more abstract and "artsy" photos for the bride and groom. I get too many candid shots to count & never miss a magic moment throughout the day. There will be something for everyone and I won't miss a thing!

Do you use a digital camera?

- Yes! I shoot with 2 Nikon digital SLR cameras. I was trained on film cameras of all types and then digital from the moment they produced the first digital SLR. There will be no fumbling around here.. I know my cameras like the back of my hand and can produce extremely high quality/resolution photos for you. It's also very easy for you to take files from your DVD and share them on your Facebook or Myspace page!

Do you copyright your photos?

- All photos taken are automatically Copyrighted by the person who took it, but I am a firm believer that you should get the photos you pay for so I make it as easy as pie to use all the photos I take for you. I am at your service and will deliver ALL of the photos I take for you with a Copyright release! I do not put my copyright on the photo files and/or charge more for a non-copyrighted product. The photos I take are all yours. With your permission, I just might use them as samples on my website and/or ask you for a referral, but that tends to happen naturally.
